- CRPD Update- Lt. Omar reviewed updated crime statistics. Overall, trends are still positive. Even though there were a few shots fired on a recent weekend, the average is still low. More letters of trespass are being written as a result of homeless people being reported by property owners. Once timing is known, all parties will be engaged to inform their respective employees, students, stakeholders, etc. to lessen the surprise.
